

THE BAILEY-WOOD-MCAFEE Scholarship Fund

The Knoxville District Baptist Missionary and Educational Association, out of a concern for encouraging the youth, created annual scholarships to be given to graduating seniors each year. The Association expanded the original scholarships given, and now we award eight *(8)* thousand dollar (\$1,000) scholarships to high school graduates and three (3) five hundred dollar (\$500) to ministerial students enrolled in seminaries.

The KDBA annual scholarships are recommended by the Woods-Bailey-McAfee Scholarship Committee. The committee is named for the following:

MRS. FRANCES "FANNIE" WOODS, wife of the late Rev. J. C. Woods. Mrs. Woods was a former President of the Women's Department of the Knoxville District and former President of the Tennessee Baptist Missionary and Educational Convention.

REV. H. J. BAILEY served for more than 45 years as Pastor of the Payne Avenue Baptist Church and a stalwart for educational support. Other places served were: Martha Davis Baptist Church and Nelson-Merry School in Jefferson City, Tennessee.

REV. EDMOND MCAFEE served churches in Kentucky and served as Pastor of True Light, Victory View, and Bethany Baptist Churches. He served for a number of years as Chairman of the Finance Commission of the District.


