Working on the Front Line / Compassion Coalition (Gina Bozeman-Whitmore)

Every church seems to be bombarded with all kinds of requests for assistance – financial and otherwise. Compassion Coalition, a regional leader in church partnerships will be leading this training in maximizing our Lord’s resources for local mission. How do we know if we are doing more harm than good? This course is intended to prepare those who are usually the first responders in the churches to requests for aid.

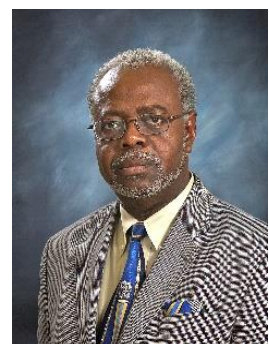
The Parolee’s Re-entry into the Community (Keira Wyatt)

This class will present options, opportunities, and training for churches to establish a partnership with CONNECT Ministries to aide those returning from incarceration with their re-entry into society.



Communicating Your Faith (Dr. Reginald Butler)

This class will provide basic instruction on witnessing using various techniques including 1-5-1 methodology. Pastors, grow your church outside of the walls. Ministry leaders, expand your ministry through evangelism. Individuals, learn to exercise your faith in new and effective ways.



Your Church and Addiction Recovery Ministry (Dr. Monty Burks)

This session will present options and opportunities for pastors and churches to establish a partnership with the State of Tennessee for addiction prevention, treatment, and / or resourcing.
